Due to the spread of the Covid-19 disease and the significant increase in cases in our immediate environments, every member of the community is called upon to wear a mask in private as well as public places.

In order to safeguard the wellbeing of members of the embassy and according to the requirements of the host country concerning the curbing down of the spread of " Covid-19 ", the following measures have been taken : Rules of social distancing must be observed; Meetings are strictly for important reasons; Working remotely is encouraged ; Working in small groups is encouraged within tiny spaces and rotatory attendance is necessary.
